Pastoral Burnout Prevention

- Keeping proper **priorities**: 1. Relationship to God, 2. Relationship to Spouse and Children 3. Relationship to the Church and the Ministry
- Keeping proper perspective: Our relationship to God is NOT our ministry. Ministry is our vocation. God deserves our devotion. Our ministry must never become our god. That is idolatry of the first order.
- Keeping proper people priorities: In the home, marriage is the first order of business at all times. Without a solid, Christ centered partnership with our spouse we do not have ministry. Children come after the marriage and must be in that order of priority. They are invited guests but have no permanence. Only Dad and Mom are permanent residents of the home. We must lead our people by example in these matters.
- Keeping proper personal precaution: God is our devotion, ministry our vocation but we must also have an avocation to keep us healthy and balanced.
